

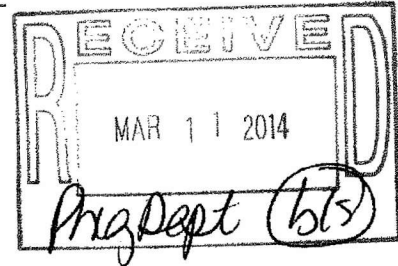


Dear Mr. Chairman and Members:

We appreciate the opportunity to informally present what is likely to be our last large scale, ground mounted solar project under the existing regulatory system. Roof mounted solar systems remain a priority for the company at 200 and 300 Rosebrook Way or other appropriately sized roof mounted models for other projects that allow for self-generation of power at the project site.

The project before you and the Conservation Commission is known as Tihonet East Solar. The Tihonet East Solar Energy Project is a 6 mw facility proposed on a 49.5± acre site. The solar array itself will occupy approximately 25 acres of the site. The Project is located off the unimproved portion of Tihonet Road east of Tihonet Pond in Wareham and south of the Wareham/Plymouth town line. The proposed location of the solar array area is approximately 3,000 feet from the nearest residential lot. Furthermore the project location is outside of any wetlands or buffer zone. **This project is the same cookie cutter solar project like Charlotte Furnace and Tihonet West solar in Wareham and Federal Road in Carver.** Coordination with the Wareham Fire District will ensure that safe access is provided on a year round basis prior to the initiation of construction.

We look forward to completing the formal permitting process with the Conservation Commission and Planning Board.
