RE: Request for Waiver for Emergency Shoreline Repair, Long Beach, Plymouth, MA

Dear Chairman Ieronimo and members of the Carver Earth Removal Committee,

Pursuant to Carver Town Counsel's interpretation of Section 9.1.8 of the Town's Earth Removal Bylaw, an earth removal permit is not required with Town, state and /or federal projects, provided the operation does not constitute a nuisance or danger to the public and conforms to accepted engineering and / or agricultural practices. In the opinion of Town Counsel, the work described in the letter provided previously by the Town of Plymouth regarding the Long Beach project does qualify as such an exemption.

The exemption for the Long Beach project is set to begin Monday, February 13 and should be completed no later than Wednesday, April 1, 2023. The hours of operation will coincide with our current permits, Monday -Friday 7AM to 330PM. Fifty (50) trucks per day will provide material for this project. Those trucks will follow the designated truck route down Federal Road to Farm to Market Road to Tihonet Road in Wareham. All current dust and safety measures will be followed as outlined in our existing permits. The material for this project will consist of beach nourishment stone, which is stockpiled, along with a small percentage of beach sand. All material for the above-mentioned project will be sourced from property owned by A.D. Makepeace located off Federal Road (Map 131, Lot 2-4) which falls under earth removal permit 65. (ADM Pit #17).
